What is NeuLand?

NeuLand is a community garden located in the middle of the city. Everyone can take part and learn from each other. There are wooden planter boxes filled with earth in which you can grow organic vegetables, fruit, herbs and flowers.

How does the NeuLand community gardening project work?

The garden is divided into little plots. If you like, you can adopt one particular plot. One plot usually consists of four to six planter boxes, half of which you can plant however you like. The other half you plant for the community, so that

everyone can benefit from it. At least once a week everyone works together to make the garden prettier. Sometimes we cook and eat together too. Everybody helps with the watering. You can find gardening supplies in the tool shed. We don't use chemicals because this is an organic garden. The

other gardeners will gladly show you how everything works. We will show you around

Why do we garden in planter boxes?

Because the ground isn't good for planting and because this way we are able to move. This garden cannot stay here forever: in a few years this area

will be built up and we will have to move somewhere else.

When can I come?

Any time—the garden is always open. Every Saturday from 2 to 5 pm is when we work together. This is a good time to meet nice people and participate.

Does it cost money?

No. The Kölner NeuLand e.V. covers the costs for people with no or little income.
